

EVENT OVERVIEW

The insular Caribbean is a major biodiversity hotspot but is highly vulnerable to biological invasions, particularly by terrestrial vertebrates, which remain understudied and difficult to manage.

In this context, Caribaea Initiative will host a major event bringing together researchers, protected area managers and conservation practitioners from across the Caribbean and beyond.

The event aims to strengthen regional research capacity, encourage experience sharing, and foster scientific and technical cooperation between Caribbean territories.

The programme will combine

- Scientific presentations and plenary lectures
- Training sessions on tools and methodologies
- Round-table discussions on ethics, policy and regional cooperation
